Eligibility: A pass in Plus two or equivalent examination.

B. Com with Computer Application

Eligibility: A pass in Plus two or equivalent examination with Commerce group or plus two any group with 45% marks under Part - III.

B. Com Finance

Eligibility: A pass in Plus two or equivalent examination with Commerce group or plus two any group with 45% marks under Part - III.

B.Com Co-Operation

Eligibility: A pass in Plus two or equivalent examination with Commerce group or plus two any group with 45% marks under Part - III.

BBA

Eligibility: A pass in Plus two or equivalent examination with 50% marks minimum.

BCA

Eligibility: A pass in Plus two or equivalent examination with Mathematics / Computer application/Computer Science / Informatics or equivalent.

B.Sc Physics

(Complementary papers : Chemistry & Mathematics)
Eligibility: A pass in Plus two Science group with Physics
as a subject of study or equivalent examination

B.Sc Mathematics

(Complementary papers : Statistics & Physics) Eligibility: A pass in Plus two with Mathematics as a subject of study or equivalent examination

B.Sc Psychology

(Complementary papers : Human Physiology and Psychological Statistics)


Eligibility: A pass in Plus two or equivalent examination.

(Complementary papers: Mathematics & Physics)

Eligibility: A pass in Plus two science group with Chemistry as a subject of study or equivalent examination





M. Com Finance

Eligibility: B Com/BBA/BBS/BBM Degree of this University or equivalent degree with at least 45% marks for Part III. OBC/OEC candidates are eligible to relaxation up to 5%. SC/ST candidates need only to get a pass.

MA English

Eligibility: The minimum marks prescribed for admission to MA in English Degree course is 45% in Part I English of BA/B.Sc examinations or 45% in English main papers 'in the case of candidates with under part III pattern I or 45% in English main papers in the case of candidates with English under part III pattern II. Candidates will be ranked according to the percentage of marks in part I English or part III in the case of those who have taken English under part III whichever is higher. A weightage of 10% marks shall be added in the case of those who have taken English under part III.









How to Apply

All candidates seeking admission to UG/PG programmes irrespective of the Quota (Management/General Merit/Reservation/Sports/Persons with disabilities) should compulsorily register through Centralized Admission Process(CAP) of University of Calicut (http://cuonline.ac.in). The candidates who have not registered through CAP will not be permitted to take admission at any stage of the admission process.

Candidates seeking admission through the management/sports quota should contact the college office and submit separate application in addition to CAP registration. Application form and prospectus can be obtained from the college office on payment of Rs. 300/-

Candidates must attach a copy of the mark list of their qualification examination and 10th certificate to the application form. Before filling the application form please read the prospectus carefully.

Mode of Selection

50% of the seats will be filled from the general merit list provided by the university and the remaining seats are management quota.

From the available applications for management quota rank list will be published on the notice board and candidates provisionally selected for admission will be informed.
