ORIENTATION PROGRAM FOR FRESHERS

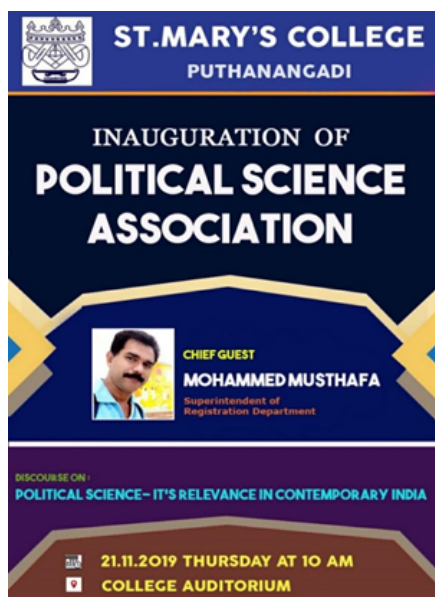
SEPTEMBER 12, 2019

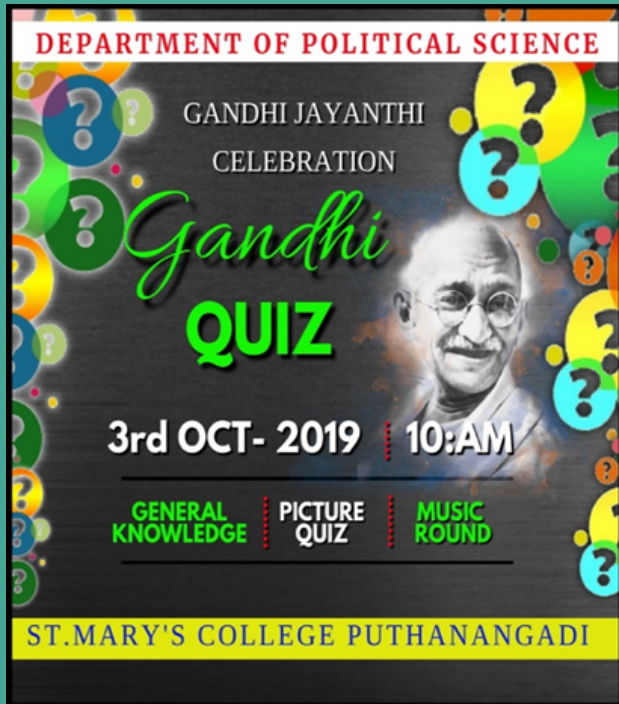


2019 ASSOCIATION INAUGURATION
